Instructions For This Packet

Page 1: Diagnostics Summary: Use it as a guide. Think of it as an index to the curriculum.

Diagnostics Overview: Ask the students to do the problems in each of the sections to determine if the student understands a given module or not. If the student understands the module, then move on to the next module. If the student is struggling in a module, then your job is to determine which packet within the module the student is struggling in. You can do that by asking questions that are related to each packet [It would be obvious to make up questions for the packet once you get a hang of how the modules and packets are named].

General guideline:

- K/1st Grade: Print "Diagnostic Overview: Add Sub 1d"
- 2nd Grade: Print "Diagnostics: Add Sub Below 20"
- 3rd Grade: Print "Diagnostics: Add Sub 2d-3d"

Do NOT give the diagnostic/overview sheets as homework.
